READING Acts 7.54-end

The Stoning of Stephen

When they heard these things, they
became enraged and ground their
teeth at Stephen. But filled with the
Holy Spirit, he gazed into heaven and
saw the glory of God and Jesus
standing at the right hand of God.
'Look,' he said, 'I see the heavens
opened and the Son of Man standing at
the right hand of God!' But they
covered their ears, and with a loud
shout all rushed together against him.
Then they dragged him out of the city
and began to stone him; and the
witnesses laid their coats at the feet of
a young man named Saul. While they
were stoning Stephen, he prayed,
'Lord Jesus, receive my spirit.'

Then he knelt down and cried out in a
loud voice, 'Lord, do not hold this sin
against them.' When he had said this,
he died.

GOSPEL Matthew 23.34-end

Therefore I send you prophets, sages,
and scribes, some of whom you will
kill and crucify, and some you will flog
in your synagogues and pursue from
town to town, so that upon you may
come all the righteous blood shed on
earth, from the blood of righteous Abel
to the blood of Zechariah son of
Barachiah, whom you murdered
between the sanctuary and the altar.
Truly I tell you, all this will come upon
this generation.

the prophets and stones those who are
sent to it! How often have I desired to
gather your children together as a hen
gathers her brood under her wings,
and you were not willing! See, your
house is left to you, desolate. For I tell
